[Passed February 4, 1970; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section ten, chapter one hundred twenty, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-five, relating to the terms of court of the intermediate court of Ohio county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section ten, chapter one hundred twenty, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred twenty-five, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

INTERMEDIATE COURT OF OHIO COUNTY.

§10. Terms of court.

- 1 There shall be three terms of said court held in each
- 2 year, commencing on the second Monday in January,

3 April and September. Adjourned and special terms of
4 said court may be called and held as provided for special
5 and adjourned terms of the circuit court.
