(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. BOIARSKY, and MR. POTTER)

[Passed February 12, 1970; in effect July 1, 1970.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred seven, as last amended by chapter twenty-eight, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred nine; and to amend and reenact section nine, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred seven, as last amended and reenacted by chapter two hundred sixteen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred sixty-seven, relating to the jurisdiction of the intermediate court of Kanawha county and to the duties and salary of the judge thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred seven, as last amended by chapter twenty-eight, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred nine, and that section nine, chapter twenty-five, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred seven, as last amended and reenacted by chapter two hundred sixteen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred sixty-seven, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

INTERMEDIATE COURT OF KANAWHA COUNTY.

§2. Jurisdiction.

1 The said court shall have jurisdiction within the county
2 of Kanawha concurrent with the circuit court of said
3 county, of all felonies, misdemeanors, and offenses com-
4 mitted within the said county; and also of all matters
5 at law where the amount in controversy, exclusive of
6 interest and costs, does not exceed five hundred dollars.
7 And also of appeals from the judgments of the justices
8 of said county when such appeals shall lie to said court
9 in the same manner and under the same regulations,

10 as provided in the general law for appeals from justices;
11 also for the trial of all cases concurrent with the circuit
12 court, for the maintenance of illegitimate children, as
13 provided by chapter forty-eight of the code of West Vir-
14 ginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended.
15 And the court shall also have jurisdiction concurrent with
16 the circuit court of said county as to the supervision and
17 control of all proceedings before justices of said county,
18 or the mayor or police judge or police court of any in-
19 corporated city, town or village of said county, by appeals,
20 mandamus, prohibition and certiorari. Said court shall
21 also have jurisdiction concurrent with said circuit court,
22 of appeals from the police judge or the police court of
23 the city of Charleston in said county. The court shall also
24 have jurisdiction within Kanawha county, concurrent
25 with the circuit court of said county, of statutory sum-
26 mary proceedings for the sale, lease or mortgage of or
27 trust deed upon the estate of minors, insane persons and
28 convicts instituted pursuant to the provisions of section
29 eleven, article one, chapter thirty-seven of the code of
30 West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as

31 amended. The judge of said court shall each year forward
32 to the judicial council provided for in article eleven, chap-
33 ter fifty-six of said code, and without request therefor by
34 such council, his proposals for any legislative or rule
35 changes which he believes will make the administration
36 of justice more efficient.

§9. Salary.

1 The judge of the intermediate court of Kanawha county,
2 West Virginia, shall, from and after the first day of July,
3 one thousand nine hundred seventy, receive for his serv-
4 ices a salary in the amount of twenty thousand dollars
5 per annum, to be paid in monthly installments out of the
6 county treasury of Kanawha county, out of the funds
7 of said treasury, in the manner provided by statute. The
8 salary of said judge shall continue as provided in chapter
9 one hundred sixty-eight, acts of the Legislature, regular
10 session, one thousand nine hundred sixty-five, until the
11 first day of July, one thousand nine hundred seventy.
