[Passed June 19, 1970; in effect July 1, 1970.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section six-(twenty-one), article seven, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the salary of the stenographer to the prosecuting attorney of Lewis county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six-(twenty-one), article seven, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 17. SALARIES; DEPUTIES AND ASSISTANTS AND
THEIR SALARIES.**

**§7-7-6(21). Assistants, stenographers and clerks for prosecu-
ting attorney—Appointment and salaries; when
court may appoint attorney to prosecute—Lewis
county.**

1 For the county of Lewis, one assistant attorney, not
2 more than one thousand eight hundred dollars; one ste-
3 nographer, not less than two thousand nor more than
4 four thousand dollars.
