# ENROLLED <br> House Bill No. 514 

(By Mr. Edgar and Mr. Seibert)
[Passed January 27, 1970; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article one-a, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to adjutant general.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
That section four, article one-a, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 1A. ADJUTANT GENERAL.

§15-1A-4. Assistant adjutants general.
1 The governor shall appoint an assistant adjutant gen-
2 eral for air and an assistant adjutant general for army,

3 each with the rank of brigadier general, or such other 4 rank as shall be recognized by federal authority, who 5 shall be the deputy commander of the air national guard 6 and the deputy commander of the army national guard, 7 respectively. The governor may also appoint an assistant

8 adjutant general with the rank of colonel or such other 9 rank as shall be recognized by the federal authority, 10 who shall be the executive officer and administrative 11 assistant to assist the adjutant general in the adminis-

12 tration of the adjutant general's department (or depart13 ment of military affairs). The assistant adjutant general

14 serving as the executive officer and the administrative
15 assistant may also be the deputy commander of the army 16 or air national guard. The assistant adjutants general

17 shall be upon appointment, federally recognized officers 18 of the air national guard and the army national guard, 19 respectively.
