AN ACT to amend and reenact section six-(thirty), article seven, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the appointment and compensation of the stenographer to the prosecuting attorney of Mingo county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six-(thirty), article seven, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 7. SALARIES; DEPUTIES AND ASSISTANTS AND
THEIR SALARIES.**

**§7-7-6(30). Assistants, stenographers and clerks for prosecuting
attorney—Mingo county.**

1 For the county of Mingo, one assistant attorney, not
2 more than six thousand dollars; one stenographer, five
3 thousand one hundred dollars.
