Senate Bill No. 390

(Originating in the Committee on Finance)

[Passed March 8, 1972; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agency to be moral obligations of the state, and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the department of mental health to be moral obligations of the state, and directing payment thereof.

1 The Legislature has heretofore made findings of fact
2 that the state has received the benefit of the commodities
3 and services rendered by certain claimants herein and
4 has considered claims against the state and the department of mental health, an agency thereof, which have
5 arisen due to over-expenditures of departmental appropriations by officers of such state spending unit, such
6 claims having been previously considered by the court
7 of claims which also found that the state has received the
8 benefit of the commodities and services rendered by each
9 claimant, but were denied by the court of claims on the
10 purely statutory grounds that to allow such claims would
11 be condoning illegal acts contrary to the laws of the state.
12 The Legislature, pursuant to its findings of fact and also
13 by the adoption of the findings of fact by the court of
14 claims as its own, and, while not condoning such illegal
15 acts, hereby declares it to be the moral obligation of the
16 state to pay each such claim in the amount specified
17 below, and directs the auditor to issue warrants upon
18 receipt of a properly executed requisition supported by
19 an itemized invoice, statement or other satisfactory document as required by section ten, article three, chapter
20 twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine
21 hundred thirty-one, as amended, for the payment thereof
