(By MR. SPEAKER, MR. McMANUS, and MR. BURKE)

[Passed April 14, 1973; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-a, article four, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the regulation of parking on state-owned property in Charleston; fee for unauthorized parking; and responsibility for collection thereof by the commissioner of the department of finance and administration.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-a, article four, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION.

§5A-4-1a. Regulation of parking on state-owned property in Charleston; penalties; jurisdiction.

- 1 The commissioner is vested with authority to regulate park-
- 2 ing of motor vehicles in accordance with the provisions of
- 3 this section with regard to the following state-owned property
- 4 in the city of Charleston, Kanawha county:
- 5 (a) The east side of Duffy Street between Kanawha Boule-
- 6 vard and Washington Street, East;
- 7 (b) The west side of California Avenue between Kanawha
- 8 Boulevard and Washington Street, East;
- 9 (c) In the circle between the east and west wings of the
- 10 state capitol;

11 (d) Upon the state-owned grounds upon which State
12 Office Building No. 3, 1800 Washington Street, East, is
13 located;

14 (e) Upon the state-owned grounds upon which State
15 Office Building No. 4, 112 California Avenue, is located;

16 (f) In the state-owned parking garage at 212 California
17 Avenue and upon the state-owned grounds upon which such
18 parking garage is located;

19 (g) Upon the state-owned property at Michigan Avenue
20 and Virginia Terrace;

21 (h) Upon any other property now or hereafter owned by
22 the state and used for parking purposes in conjunction with
23 the state capitol or State Office Buildings Nos. 3 and 4.

24 The commissioner is authorized to promulgate rules and
25 regulations respecting parking and to allocate parking spaces
26 to public officers and employees of the state upon all of the
27 aforementioned property of the state: *Provided*, That all park-
28 ing spaces in the circle between the east and west wings of
29 the state capitol shall at all times be kept available for parking
30 by visitors at the capitol: *Provided, however*, That during
31 sessions of the Legislature or during legislative interim com-
32 mittee meetings parking on the east side of Duffy Street between
33 Kanawha Boulevard and Washington Street, East, and in the
34 circle between the east and west wings of the capitol shall be
35 subject to rules and regulations promulgated jointly by the
36 speaker of the House of Delegates and the president of the
37 Senate. Any person parking any vehicle without authorization
38 and contrary to the rules and regulations promulgated under
39 authority of this section shall be charged a fee of two dollars.
40 The commissioner shall collect all such charges and pay the
41 same into the general revenue fund of the state.

42 All such charges are hereby declared to be debts owing
43 to the state, for which the debtor shall be personally liable,
44 and the commissioner, if necessary, may make collection
45 by appropriate civil action in any court of competent juris-
46 diction.

47 The commissioner is authorized to employ such persons as
48 may be necessary to enforce the parking rules and regula-
49 tions promulgated under the provisions of this section.
