[Passed March 9, 1974; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the commissioner of the department of public institutions to transfer a certain parcel of real estate, located in Marshall County and owned by that department, to the city of Moundsville, and a certain parcel to the County of Marshall.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§1. Commissioner of the department of public institutions authorized to transfer certain department-owned land to the city of Moundsville and the County of Marshall.

1 The commissioner of the department of public institutions
2 is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer to the city of
3 Moundsville, a tract of land, together with the improvements
4 thereon and the appurtenances thereunto belonging, owned
5 by the department, consisting of thirty acres, more or less, and
6 to transfer to the County of Marshall, a tract of land, together
7 with the improvements thereon and the appurtenances there-
8 unto belonging, owned by the department, consisting of eighty
9 acres, more or less, both being portions of the prison farm,
10 situated and located in Marshall County.
