AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article four, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to annual report of auditor; contents thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article four, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. ACCOUNTS, REPORTS AND GENERAL PROVISIONS.

§12-4-7. Annual report of auditor.

1 The annual report of the auditor shall be furnished to
2 the governor within one week after the end of the fiscal
3 year. It shall contain a statement of the receipts and
4 disbursements, under the proper general heads, during
5 the preceding fiscal year, and show the balance in the
6 treasury at the beginning and end of that year. It shall
7 also contain an estimate of the revenue and expenditures
8 for the current year, with similar statements and estimates
9 respecting the school fund. It shall show the indebtedness
10 of the state and the balances standing at the end of the
11 year to the credit of the several unexpired appropriations,
12 specifying in each case the date when the appropriation
13 was made. The report shall be accompanied with such
14 remarks as may serve to explain the amounts of receipts
15 and disbursements and the balances and estimates re-
16 ported. In it the auditor shall point out any defects which
17 may occur to him in the revenue laws and suggest the
18 proper remedies, and if, in his opinion, the future revenue

19 be likely to prove insufficient, he shall recommend plans
20 for increasing the revenue and suggest such new subjects
21 of taxation, or such additional taxes on the old, as he may
22 deem proper.

23 The annual report shall contain an alphabetical listing
24 of all regular state employees and all part-time, casual or
25 per diem state workers, as the case may be, with a state-
26 ment of the account or accounts from which such person
27 is paid, the amount paid from the designated and num-
28 bered account and the total amount paid to such indi-
29 vidual from all accounts.

30 The annual report shall also contain an alphabetical
31 listing of all vendors from whom the state has made
32 purchases during the period reported, the designated and
33 numbered account or accounts, as the case may be, and the
34 total amount paid by the state to such vendor.
