AN ACT to amend and reenact section two-a, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to establishing, continuing or increasing the salaries of certain appointive state officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two-a, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7. COMPENSATION AND ALLOWANCES.

§6-7-2a. Terms of certain appointive state officers; appointment; qualifications; powers and salaries of such officers.

1 Notwithstanding any other provision of this code to the
2 contrary, each of the appointive state officers named in
3 this section shall be appointed by the governor, by and
4 with the advice and consent of the Senate. Each of such
5 appointive state officers shall serve at the will and plea-
6 sure of the governor for the term for which the governor
7 was elected and until the respective state officers' suc-
8 cessors have been appointed and qualified. Each of such
9 appointive state officers shall hereafter be subject to the
10 existing qualifications for holding each such respective
11 office and each shall have and is hereby granted all of
12 the powers and authority and shall perform all of the
13 functions and services heretofore vested in and performed
14 by virtue of existing law respecting each such office.

15 (a) Each of the following named state appointive
16 officers shall continue to receive an annual salary as
17 follows: members of the board of review of employment
18 security and members of workmen's compensation appeal
19 board, fourteen thousand dollars; and members of the
20 board of probation and parole, sixteen thousand dollars.

21 (b) Effective the first day of July, one thousand nine
22 hundred seventy-seven, the annual salary of each of the
23 following named state appointive officers shall be as fol-
24 lows: The commissioner of highways, thirty-nine thousand
25 dollars; commissioner of finance and administration, thirty-
26 seven thousand five hundred dollars; tax commissioner,
27 thirty-nine thousand dollars; director of the department of
28 natural resources, thirty-seven thousand five hundred dol-
29 lars; commissioner of the department of welfare, thirty-
30 seven thousand five hundred dollars; superintendent of de-
31 partment of public safety, thirty-five thousand dollars;
32 alcohol beverage control commissioner, thirty thousand
33 dollars; commissioner of banking, thirty thousand dollars;
34 director of the department of mines, thirty-five thousand
35 dollars; state workmen's compensation commissioner,
36 thirty thousand dollars; director of personnel, civil service
37 commission, thirty thousand dollars; commissioner of cor-
38 rections, thirty thousand dollars; commissioner of culture
39 and history, thirty thousand dollars; labor commissioner,
40 twenty-eight thousand dollars; commissioner of employ-
41 ment security, twenty-eight thousand dollars; insurance
42 commissioner, twenty-eight thousand dollars; commis-
43 sioner of motor vehicles, thirty thousand dollars; adjutant
44 general, twenty-six thousand dollars; director of emer-
45 gency services, twenty-five thousand dollars; nonintoxicat-
46 ing beer commissioner, twenty-five thousand dollars; and
47 the director of veterans affairs, twenty-five thousand dol-
48 lars.
