[Passed March 9, 1978; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article one, chapter twenty-nine-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to application of chapter twenty-nine-a of said code to the West Virginia board of education and the board of governors of West Virginia University.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article one, chapter twenty-nine-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. DEFINITIONS AND APPLICATION OF CHAPTER.

§29A-1-2. Application of chapter.

1 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to rules
2 relating to, or contested cases involving, public elections,
3 the conduct of inmates of public institutions, the conduct
4 of students at public schools or public educational institutions,
5 the conduct of persons in military service or the
6 receipt of public assistance.

7 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in any
8 respect whatever to the West Virginia board of probation
9 and parole, the public service commission, and the board
10 of public works: *Provided*, That these named agencies
11 shall comply with section one, article two of this chapter:
12 *Provided, however*, That any rule promulgated by any
13 such named agency on and after the effective date of this
14 chapter shall not become effective unless and until two
15 certified copies of such rule have been on file in the
16 office of the secretary of state for sixty consecutive days.
