AN ACT to amend and reenact section three-a, article nine, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to excluding auxiliary and service personnel salaries from publication requirement.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three-a, article nine, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 9. SCHOOL FINANCES.

## §18-9-3a. Preparation, publication and disposition of financial statements by county boards of education.

- 1 The county board of education of every county, within
- 2 four weeks after the beginning of each fiscal year, shall prepare
- 3 on a form to be prescribed by the state tax commissioner
- 4 and the state superintendent of free schools, and cause to be
- 5 published a statement revealing (a) the receipts and expendi-
- 6 tures of the board during the previous fiscal year arranged
- 7 under descriptive headings, (b) the name of each firm, cor-
- 8 poration and person who received more than fifty dollars
- 9 in the aggregate from all funds during the previous fiscal

year, together with the aggregate amount received from all 11 funds and the purpose for which paid: Provided, That such 12 statement shall not include the name of any person who has 13 entered into a contract with this board pursuant to the provisions of sections two, three, four and five, article two, 14 15 chapter eighteen-a of this code, and (c) all debts of the board, 16 the purpose for which each debt was contracted, its due date, and to what date the interest thereon has been paid. Such 17 18 statement shall be published as a Class I-O legal advertise-19 ment in compliance with the provisions of article three, chapter fifty-nine of this code, and the publication area for such 20 21 publication shall be the county. The county board of education 22 shall pay the cost of publishing such statement from the main-23 tenance fund of the board.

As soon as is practicable following the close of the fiscal year, a copy of the published statement herein required shall be filed by the county board of education with the state tax commissioner and with the state superintendent of free schools.

29 The county board of education shall transmit to any resi-30 dent of the county requesting the same a copy of the published 31 statement for the fiscal year designated, supplemented by a 32 list of the names of all school personnel employed by the 33 board during such fiscal year showing the amount paid to each, and a list of the names of each firm, corporation, and 34 person who received less than fifty dollars from any fund 35 36 during such fiscal year showing the amount paid to each and 37 the purpose for which paid.
