

AN ACT to amend and reenact section fifteen, article four-a, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to liens upon the titles to motor vehicles and the length of such liens; length of liens on mobile homes; refiling.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fifteen, article four-a, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4A. LIENS AND ENCUMBRANCES ON VEHICLES TO BE SHOWN ON CERTIFICATE OF TITLE; NOTICE TO CREDITORS AND PURCHASERS.

§17A-4A-15. Liens or encumbrances void after ten years unless refiled; refiling for additional two-year periods; deletion from lien index.

- 1 The filing of any lien or encumbrance and its recordation
- 2 upon the face of a certificate of title to any vehicle as provided
- 3 in this article shall be valid for a period of ten years only from

the date of such filing, unless the lien or encumbrance is refiled 4 5 in the manner provided in this article for filing and recordation in the first instance, in which event the lien or encumbrance 6 7 shall be valid for successive additional periods of two years from the date of each such refiling: Provided, That in the case 8 9 of a mobile home, the filing of any lien or encumbrance and its recordation upon the face of a certificate of title to such 10 mobile home shall be valid for a period of fifteen years from 11 the date of such filing. 12

When the last lien or encumbrance shown on a certificate of title becomes invalid by the passage of time as provided in this section, the commissioner of motor vehicles shall not be required to maintain a lien index as to such certificate of title. 3 [Enr. Com. Sub. for H. B. 1379
