AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article two, chapter fourtcen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the appointment of deputy clerks by the court.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, article two, chapter fourteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

§14-2-5. Court clerk and other personnel.

1 The court shall have the authority to appoint a clerk and 2 deputy clerks. The salaries of the clerk and the deputy clerks 3 shall be fixed by the joint committee on government and finance, and shall be paid out of the regular appropriation for 4 5 the court. The clerk shall have custody of all records and 6 proceedings of the court, shall attend meetings and hearings of the court, shall administer oaths and affirmations, and shall 7 8 issue all official summonses, subpoenas, orders, statements 9 and awards. A deputy clerk shall act in the place and stead 10 of the clerk in the clerk's absence.

11 The joint committee on government and finance may em-12 ploy other persons whose services shall be necessary to the 13 orderly transaction of the business of the court and fix their 14 compensation. The Joint Committee on Enrolled Bills hereby certifies that the foregoing bill is correctly enrolled.
