AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article two, chapter fourteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to compensation and expenses of judges of the court of claims.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight, article two, chapter fourteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

§14-2-8. Compensation of judges; expenses.

Each judge of the court shall receive one hundred forty 1 2 dollars for each day actually served, and actual expenses 3 incurred in the performance of his duties. The number 4 of days served by each judge shall not exceed one hun-5 dred in any fiscal year, except by authority of the joint 6 committee on government and finance: Provided, That 7 in computing the number of days served, days utilized 8 solely for the exercise of duties assigned to judges and 9 commissioners by the provisions of article two-a of this 10 chapter, shall be disregarded. Requisitions for compensa-11 tion and expenses shall be accompanied by sworn and 12 itemized statements, which shall be filed with the auditor 13 and preserved as public records. For the purpose of this 14 section, time served shall include time spent in the hear-15 ing of claims, in the consideration of the record, in the 16 preparation of opinions, and in necessary travel.
