ARTICLE 5. COMMISSION ON SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS.

§4-5-5. Investigations and files confidential.

- 1 The investigations conducted by the commission and the 2 materials placed in the files of the commission are exempt 3 from public disclosure under the provisions of chapter twenty-
- 4 nine-b of this code.
