AN ACT to amend article five, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section five, relating to exempting the commission on special investigations from the freedom of information act.

That article five, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section five, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. COMMISSION ON SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS.

§4-5-5. Investigations and files confidential.

- 1 The investigations conducted by the commission and the
- 2 materials placed in the files of the commission are exempt
- 3 from public disclosure under the provisions of chapter twenty-
- 4 nine-b of this code.
