AN ACT to amend article five, chapter eighteen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section nine, relating to the duty of teachers to report to a school nurse any pupil who regularly attends classes in an unsanitary condition; and requiring the school nurse to report chronic conditions to certain state agencies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article five, chapter eighteen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section nine, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORITY; RIGHTS; RESPONSIBILITY.

§18A-5-9. Duty to report lack of personal cleanliness.

1 It shall be the duty of every teacher to report to a school
2 nurse and the pupil's parents the name and address of any
3 pupil who regularly appears for classes in filthy or unsanitary
4 clothing, lacking in personal cleanliness, infested with body
5 lice, infected with chronic sores or lesions or otherwise in any
6 state of personal hygiene that is dangerous to such pupil's
7 health or to the health of others. The school nurse shall report

8 students who are chronically affected by the conditions set
9 forth herein to the department of human services or the
10 department of health.
