[Passed April 8, 1985; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section six, article three, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to interpretation of school laws and rules by the state superintendent of schools; requiring the state superintendent to request an opinion from the attorney general upon a written request from a state or county officer or any state organization of school employees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section six, article three, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. STATE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS.

§18-3-6. Interpretation of school laws and rules of state board of education.

1 At the request in writing of any citizen, teacher, school
2 official, county or state officer, the state superintendent
3 of schools shall give his interpretation of the meaning
4 of any part of the school laws or of the rules of the
5 state board of education. The state superintendent is
6 required to request an opinion from the state attorney
7 general as to the meaning of any part of the school
8 laws upon written request for such opinion by any county
9 or state officer or any state organization of school em-
10 ployees.
