[Passed April 13, 1985; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine, article three, chapter twenty-one-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the frequency of regular meetings of the state advisory council in the department of employment security; specifying certain months during which regular meetings are to be held; exact date and time to be set by commissioner.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section nine, article three, chapter twenty-one-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. ADVISORY COUNCIL.

§21A-3-9. Meetings.

1 The council shall hold one regular meeting in May and one
2 regular meeting in November each year. The exact date and
3 time of each regular meeting shall be determined by the
4 commissioner. Special meetings may be convened on the call
5 of the commissioner, the governor, or a majority of the
6 members.
