AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article ten, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to scheduling agencies for termination pursuant to the West Virginia sunset law.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section four, article ten, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 10. THE WEST VIRGINIA SUNSET LAW.**

**§4-10-4. Termination of governmental entities or programs.**

1       The following governmental entities and programs  
2 shall be terminated on the date indicated but no  
3 governmental entity or program shall be terminated  
4 under this article unless a performance audit has been  
5 conducted of such entity or program, except as autho-  
6 rized under section fourteen of this article:

7       (1) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
8 hundred eighty-one: Judicial council of West Virginia;  
9 geological and economic survey commission; motor  
10 vehicle certificate appeal board; child welfare licensing  
11 board.

12       (2) On the first day of July, one thousand nine

13 hundred eighty-two: Ohio River basin commission;  
14 commission on postmortem examination; state commis-  
15 sion on manpower, training and technology.

16 (3) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
17 hundred eighty-three: Anatomical board; economic  
18 opportunity advisory committee; community develop-  
19 ment authority board.

20 (4) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
21 hundred eighty-four: The following programs of the  
22 department of natural resources: Rabies control, work  
23 incentive program; West Virginia alcoholic beverage  
24 control licensing advisory board.

25 (5) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
26 hundred eighty-five: Beautification commission; labor  
27 management advisory council.

28 (6) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
29 hundred eighty-six: Health resources advisory council.

30 (7) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
31 hundred eighty-seven: The geological and economic  
32 survey; the commission on uniform state laws; West  
33 Virginia health care cost review authority; department  
34 of labor; civil service commission advisory board;  
35 council of finance and administration; motorcycle safety  
36 standards and specifications board; oil and gas inspec-  
37 tors' examining board; board of social work examiners;  
38 division of archives and history, department of culture  
39 and history; and the public employees insurance board.

40 (8) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
41 hundred eighty-eight: Veteran's council; labor manage-  
42 ment relations board; board of investments; records  
43 management and preservation advisory committee;  
44 minimum wage rate board; Ohio River valley water  
45 sanitation commission; southern regional education  
46 board; department of corrections; board of regents;  
47 commission on mass transportation.

48 (9) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
49 hundred eighty-nine: Mental retardation advisory  
50 committee; interagency committee on pesticides; com-  
51 mission on charitable organizations; board of school

52 finance; veteran's affairs advisory council; emergency  
53 medical services advisory council; pesticides board of  
54 review; reclamation commission; information system  
55 advisory commission.

56 (10) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
57 hundred ninety: Consumer affairs advisory council;  
58 savings and loan association; forest industries industrial  
59 foundation; U.S. geological survey program within the  
60 department of natural resources; drivers' license  
61 advisory board; the following divisions or programs of  
62 the department of agriculture: Soil conservation com-  
63 mittee, rural resource division, meat inspection pro-  
64 gram; women's commission; office of workers' compen-  
65 sation commissioner.

66 (11) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
67 hundred ninety-one: State advisory council of the  
68 department of employment security; department of  
69 human services; oil and gas conservation commission.

70 (12) On the first day of July, one thousand nine  
71 hundred ninety-two: state water resources board; water  
72 resources division, department of natural resources;  
73 state board of risk and insurance management; West  
74 Virginia's membership in the interstate commission on  
75 the Potomac River basin; medical services fund advisory  
76 council; board of banking and financial institutions;  
77 state building commission; the capitol building and  
78 grounds preservation commission; the public service  
79 commission: *Provided*, That in the case of the public  
80 service commission, the performance and fiscal audit  
81 required by this article shall be completed and trans-  
82 mitted to the joint committee on government and  
83 finance on or before the first day of July, one thousand  
84 nine hundred ninety-one, in order that the joint commit-  
85 tee or its designated subcommittee may review the audit  
86 pursuant to the provisions of section one, article one,  
87 chapter twenty-four of this code.
