AN ACT to amend and reenact section seventeen-a, article sixteen, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to allowing legislators and certain legislative staff members to pay monthly insurance premiums directly to the public employees insurance board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seventeen-a, article sixteen, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 16. WEST VIRGINIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES INSURANCE ACT.

§5-16-17a. Members of Legislature and staff may be covered, if cost of the entire coverage is paid by such members.

1 Notwithstanding the definition of the term "employee"
2 contained in section two of this article and notwithstand-
3 ing any other provision of this article to the contrary,
4 members of the Legislature and legislative staff may
5 participate in and be covered by any insurance plan or
6 plans authorized hereunder for state officers and
7 employees, except that all members of the Legislature
8 and legislative staff who elect to participate in or to be
9 covered by any such plan or plans shall pay their
10 proportionate individual share of the full cost for all

11 group coverage on themselves and their spouses and
12 dependents, so that there will be no cost to the state for
13 the coverage of any such members, or legislative staff
14 or the spouses and dependents of either. Legislators and
15 legislative staff may pay premiums on a monthly basis
16 directly to the board.

17 As used in this section the term "legislative staff" shall
18 mean and include any employee of the state Legislature
19 whose employment is otherwise classified as temporary
20 and who is employed to perform services required by the
21 Legislature for or during its regular sessions or during
22 the interim between regular sessions and who has been
23 and is so employed during regular sessions or during the
24 interim between sessions for not less than five consecutive sessions or interims.
