AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article one-a, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing and reestablishing the commission on uniform state laws following a performance and fiscal audit by the joint committee on government operations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section five, article one-a, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 1A. COMMISSION ON UNIFORM STATE LAWS.**

**§29-1A-5. Reestablishment of commission.**

1 After having conducted a performance and fiscal audit  
2 through its joint committee on government operations,  
3 pursuant to section nine, article ten, chapter four of this  
4 code, the Legislature hereby finds and declares that the  
5 commission on uniform state laws should be continued and  
6 reestablished. Accordingly, notwithstanding the provisions  
7 of section four, article ten, chapter four of this code, the  
8 commission on uniform state laws shall continue to exist  
9 until the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred  
10 ninety-three.
