AN ACT to amend article six, chapter sixty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-b, relating to disorderly conduct; penalty.

That article six, chapter sixty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-b, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. CRIMES AGAINST THE PEACE.

§61-6-1b. Disorderly conduct; penalty.

- 1 Any person who, in a public ~~or private~~ place, shall disturb
- 2 the peace of others by violent, profane, indecent or
- 3 boisterous conduct or language or by the making of
- 4 unreasonably loud noise that is intended to cause
- 5 annoyance or alarm to another person, and who persists in

6 such conduct after being requested to desist by a law-
7 enforcement officer acting in his lawful capacity, shall be
8 guilty of disorderly conduct, a misdemeanor, and upon
9 conviction thereof shall be fined not more than one hundred
10 dollars.
