[Passed March 10, 1987; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

- §1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the board of regents, department of education, and the department of highways, to be moral obligations of the state and directing payment thereof.**

1 The Legislature has heretofore made findings of fact that
2 the state has received the benefit of the commodities and
3 services rendered by certain claimants herein and has
4 considered claims against the state, the board of regents,
5 the department of education, and the department of
6 highways, agencies thereof, which have arisen due to over-
7 expenditures of the departmental appropriations by
8 officers of such state spending unit, such claims having
9 been previously considered by the court of claims which
10 also found that the state has received the benefit of the
11 commodities and services rendered by each claimant, but
12 were denied by the court of claims on the purely statutory

13 grounds that to allow such claims would be condoning
14 illegal acts contrary to the laws of the state. The Legislature
15 pursuant to its findings of fact and also by the adoption of
16 the findings of fact by the court of claims as its own, and,
17 while not condoning such illegal acts, hereby declares it to
18 be the moral obligation of the state to pay each such claim in
19 the amount specified below, and directs the auditor to issue
20 warrants upon receipt of a properly executed requisition
21 supported by an itemized invoice, statement or other
22 satisfactory document as required by section ten, article
23 three, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one
24 thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, for the
25 payment thereof out of any fund appropriated and
26 available for the purpose.






