AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation of public money out of the treasury from the balance of all general revenues remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, one thousand nine hundred eighty-seven, to the State Department of Health - Central Office, Account No. 4000, supplementing chapter twenty-nine, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred eighty-six, known as the budget bill.

WHEREAS, The Governor submitted to the Legislature the Executive Budget Document, at regular session, setting forth therein revenue estimates and financial statements in respect of the general revenue fund; and

WHEREAS, The Governor subsequently revised such estimates and financial statements with the latest revision being submitted to the Legislature by Executive Message No. 21 of April 2, 1987;

WHEREAS, Moneys were made newly available for appropriation and expenditure through budgetary expiration. into the state fund, general revenue of the state, and through passage of legislation which enhances the revenue estimates forthe state fund, general revenue of the state; and
