AN ACT to extend the time for the county commission of Marion County, West Virginia, to meet as a levying body for the purpose of presenting to the voters of the county an election to extend the additional county levy for mass transit, parks and recreation, and library services and equipment in Marion County from between the seventh and twenty-eighth days of March until the first Thursday in June, one thousand nine hundred eighty-eight.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

**MARION COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING AS LEVYING  
BODY EXTENDED TO CONTINUE ADDITIONAL LEVY  
FOR MASS TRANSIT, PARKS AND RECREATION, AND  
LIBRARY SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT**

**§1. Extending time for Marion County commission to meet as levying body for election to continue additional levy for mass transit, parks and recreation, and library services and equipment.**

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of article eight, chapter  
2 eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine  
3 hundred thirty-one, as amended, to the contrary, the county  
4 commission of Marion County is hereby authorized to  
5 extend the time for its meeting as a levying body and

6 certifying its actions to the state tax commissioner from  
7 between the seventh and twenty-eighth days of March until  
8 the first Thursday in June, one thousand nine hundred  
9 eighty-eight, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of  
10 Marion County the extension of the additional county levy  
11 for mass transit, parks and recreation, and library services  
12 and equipment in Marion County.
