Senate Bill No. 640

(Originating in the Committee on Finance)

[Passed March 12, 1988; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the attorney general; board of regents; department of agriculture; department of commerce; department of corrections; department of culture and history; department of education; department of finance and administration; department of health; department of health - office of the chief medical examiner; department of highways; department of human services; department of labor; department of natural resources; department of public safety; educational broadcasting authority; farm management commission; governor's office of community and industrial development; human rights commission; nonintoxicating beer commissioner; public service commission; railroad maintenance authority; secretary of state; state board of rehabilitation; state fire marshal; state tax department; supreme court of appeals; and workers' compensation fund, to be moral obligations of the state and directing payment thereof; and finding and declaring certain claims against the board of regents; department of corrections; department of finance and administration; department of health; department of highways, are not moral obligations of the state and rejecting payment thereof.

- 1 The Legislature has considered the findings of fact and
- 2 recommendations reported to it by the court of claims

3 concerning various claims against the state and agencies
4 thereof, and in respect of each to the following claims the
5 Legislature adopts those findings of fact as its own, and in
6 respect of certain claims herein, the Legislature has
7 independently made findings of fact and determinations of
8 award and hereby declares it to be the moral obligation of
9 the state to pay each such claim in the amount specified
10 below, and directs the auditor to issue warrants for the
11 payment thereof out of any fund appropriated and
12 available for the purpose. However, it is the stated intent of
13 the Legislature that any and all claims which were certified
14 by the clerk of the court of claims in accordance with
15 section twenty-three, article two, chapter fourteen of the
16 code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-
17 one, as amended, and which claims are specifically rejected
18 in this bill, are such claims which the Legislature has
19 purposely determined are not moral obligations of the State
20 of West Virginia.
