AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article two. chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the selection of deputy assessors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article two, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. ASSESSORS.

§11-2-3. Selection of deputy assessors.

- 1 The deputy assessors, including the transfer and office 2
 - deputies, shall be residents and voters in the county:
- 3 Provided, That a deputy assessor whose primary
- 4 responsibility is that of updating the assessor's maps
- 5 may be a resident and voter of a contiguous county of 6 this state. The deputy assessors shall be appointed by the
- 7 assessor with the advice and consent of the county
- 8 commission, and may be removed at any time in the
- 9 discretion of the assessor. Vacancies occurring from any
- cause in the office of any deputy assessor shall be filled 10
- 11 by the assessors.
