AN ACT to amend article twenty-four, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section eleven, relating to fees and other money collected at state institutions of higher education; and providing for an additional fee to be imposed upon health sciences students at West Virginia University, Marshall University School of Medicine and West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine for offsetting the cost of health sciences education at these schools of medicine, providing for special accounts in the state treasury and appropriations by the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article twenty-four, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section eleven, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 24. FEES AND OTHER MONEY COLLECTED AT STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

§18-24-11. Health Professions Education Fee.

1 In addition to the fees specifically provided for in 2 sections one, one-a, one-b and one-c of this article, all 3 students enrolled for credit at the West Virginia

6 Osteopathic Medicine, shall pay a health professions 7 education fee. The board of trustees shall fix the amount 8 of the fee and may from time to time change that 9 amount. The fee imposed by this section is in addition 10 to the maximum fees allowed to be collected under the 11 provisions of section one of this article and is not limited 12 thereby. Refunds of the fee may be made in the same 13 manner as any other fee collected at state institutions 14 of higher education. All moneys collected from the 15 health professions education fees shall be deposited in 16 a special revenue account for the respective school from 17 which collection is made, said accounts shall be hereby 18 created in the state treasury for the West Virginia 19 health sciences center, Marshall University School of 20Medicine, and the West Virginia School of Osteopathic 21Medicine. The moneys in such fund shall be used to 22offset general operating costs for health sciences 23education in this state. Before the thirty-first day of 24 June of each year, the board of trustees shall provide 25the legislative auditor with a report of the projected fee 26collections during the next fiscal year and a report of 27fee expenditures for the preceding fiscal year.
