[Passed April 8, 1989; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article seven, chapter fifty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to providing that a pending action based upon a personal injury does not abate or change in substance when the injured person dies as a result of such injury; and providing that another action may also be prosecuted for wrongful death.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight, article seven, chapter fifty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7. ACTIONS FOR INJURIES.

§55-7-8. Personal injury action where injuries result in death.

- Where an action is brought by a person injured for
- 2 damage caused by the wrongful act, neglect or default
- 3 of any person or corporation, and the person injured
- 4 dies as a result thereof, the action shall not abate by
- 5 reason of his or her death but, his or her death being
- 6 suggested, it may be revived in the name of his or her

- 7 personal representative, and the complaint shall be
- 8 amended so as to conform to an action under sections
- 9 five and six of this article, and the case proceeded with
- 10 as if the action had been brought under said sections.
- 11 Additionally a separate and distinct cause of action
- 12 may be brought, and if brought, shall be joined in the
- 13 same proceeding for damages incurred between the
- 14 time of injury and death where not otherwise pro-
- 15 vided for in said sections five and six. In either case
- 16 there shall be but one recovery for each element of
- 17 damages: Provided, That nothing in this section shall
- 18 be construed in derogation of the provisions of section
- 19 twelve of this article.
