Senate Bill No. 14

(BY SENATORS SPEARS, BRACKENRICH AND J. MANCHIN)

[Passed January 29, 1990; to take effect July 1, 1990.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article twenty, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the women's commission and correcting designation of ex officio members.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article twenty, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 20. WOMEN'S COMMISSION.

§29-20-1. Creation; membership; appointment and terms of members; organization; reimbursement for expenses.

1 The West Virginia commission on the status of
2 women is hereby abolished, and there is hereby
3 created within the office of the governor the West
4 Virginia women's commission, to consist of seventeen
5 members, six of whom shall be ex officio members,
6 not entitled to vote: The attorney general, the state
7 superintendent of schools, the commissioner of labor,
8 the commissioner of human services, the director of

9 the human rights commission and the director of the
10 division of personnel. Each ex officio member may
11 designate one representative employed by his depart-
12 ment to meet with the commission in his absence. The
13 governor shall appoint the additional eleven members,
14 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate,
15 from among the citizens of the state. The governor
16 shall designate the chairman and vice chairman of the
17 commission and the commission may elect such other
18 officers as it deems necessary. The members shall
19 serve a term beginning the first day of July, one
20 thousand nine hundred seventy-seven, three to serve
21 for a term of one year, four to serve for a term of two
22 years and the remaining four to serve for a term of
23 three years. The successors of the members initially
24 appointed as provided herein shall be appointed for a
25 term of three years each in the same manner as the
26 members initially appointed under this article, except
27 that any person appointed to fill a vacancy occurring
28 prior to the expiration of the term for which his
29 predecessor was appointed shall be appointed for the
30 remainder of such term. Each member shall serve
31 until the appointment and qualification of his
32 successor.

33 No member may receive any salary for his services,
34 but each may be reimbursed for actual and necessary
35 expenses incurred by him in the performance of his
36 duties out of funds received by the commission under
37 section four of this article, except that in the event the
38 expenses are paid, or are to be paid, by a third party,
39 the members shall not be reimbursed by the
40 commission.

41 Pursuant to the provisions of section four, article
42 ten, chapter four of this code, the West Virginia
43 women's commission shall continue to exist until the
44 first day of July, one thousand nine hundred ninety-
45 one, to allow for the completion of an audit by the
46 joint committee on government operations.
