AN ACT supplementing, amending, reducing and transferring specified unexpended amounts in account no. 6698-95, appropriated surplus balance, and transferring such specified amounts for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-two, to the department of health and human resources, consolidated medical service fund, account no. 4190, all amending chapter thirteen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-one, known as the budget bill.

WHEREAS, The governor submitted to the Legislature a revised statement of revenues, expenditures and changes in fund balance for the general revenue fund in executive message no. 2 dated October 1, 1991, setting forth appropriated surplus balance as of the thirty-first day of July, one thousand nine hundred ninety-one, of twenty-one million eight hundred sixty-eight thousand dollars; and

WHEREAS, Such appropriated surplus balance has been deposited in account no. 6698-95 in the treasury, in accordance with section eight, chapter thirteen, acts of the

Legislature, one thousand nine hundred ninety-one, and remains unexpended on the date of the above-mentioned executive message; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the amount of one million thirty-seven thousand two hundred ninety-four dollars be transferred from account no. 6698-95, appropriated surplus balance, to account no. 4190, as set forth in chapter thirteen, acts of the Legislature, one thousand nine hundred ninety-one, to be added to said account no. 4190 as follows:

23 The further purpose of this supplementary appropri-
 24 ation is to provide additional funding for in-home
 25 health care services as provided by the community
 26 care program within the department of health and

27 human resources. Said supplemental appropriation
28 shall not be used for administrative costs except that
29 no more than \$62,000 may be used for monitoring the
30 provision of client care.
