AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine, article two, chapter twenty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to information required to be published by the public service commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section nine, article two, chapter twenty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. POWERS AND DUTIES OF PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION.

§24-2-9. Information concerning rates, etc., of public utilities may be required and published by commission.

1 The commission may at any time require persons,
2 firms, companies, associations, corporations or municipi-
3 palities, subject to the provisions of this chapter, to
4 furnish any information which may be in their posses-
5 sion, respecting rates, tolls, charges or practices in
6 conducting their service, and to furnish the commission
7 at all times for inspection any books or papers or reports
8 and statements, which reports and statements shall be
9 under oath, when so required by the commission, and
10 the form of all reports required under this chapter shall

11 be prescribed by the commission (except as provided in
12 section five, article three of this chapter). The commis-
13 sion shall collect, receive and preserve the same, and
14 shall annually tabulate and publish the same in
15 statistical form.
