ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 538

(By Senators J. Manchin, Jones, Humphreys, Minard, Wagner, Wiedebusch and Boley)

[Passed March 9, 1991; to take effect July 1, 1991.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section twenty-four, article six, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to posting job announcements in the civil service system; and requiring appointing authorities to post the status of the position within thirty days after the end of the job announcement posting period.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twenty-four, article six, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. CIVIL SERVICE SYSTEM.

§29-6-24. Posting of job announcement notices; posting of status of position at end of announcement period.

- 1 Whenever a job opening occurs within the classified
- 2 service, the appointing authority shall, in addition to
- 3 any other requirement of law or regulation for the
- 4 posting of job opening notices, at least ten working
- 5 days before making an appointment to fill the job

6 opening, post a job announcement notice within the 7 building or facility where the duties of the job will be 8 performed and throughout the agency stating that a 9 job opening has occurred and describing the duties to 10 be performed by a person employed in that position, 11 and the qualifications required to fill that position.

12 Within thirty days after the posting period has ended, the appointing authority shall post a notice in the same place stating whether the position has been 14 15 filled. If the position has been filled, the notice shall state who was selected to fill the position and his or 17 her qualifications. If the position has not been filled, 18 the notice shall state the current status of the position, including whether: (1) The appointing authority still 19 20 intends to fill the position; (2) applications may still be 21submitted; (3) an appointment will be made from 22previous applicants; (4) the position has been "frozen" 23or eliminated; or (5) any other information needed to 24adequately inform existing and potential applicants for 25 the position.
