AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article two, chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to apportionment of the Senate into seventeen senatorial districts for the purpose of electing thirty-four members; defining terms; and requiring all actions necessary and related to such apportionment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article two, chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. APPORTIONMENT OF REPRESENTATION.

§1-2-1. Senatorial districts.

(a) This section shall be known and may be cited as
 "The Senate Redistricting Act of 1991".

3 (b) As used in this section:

4 (1) "County" means the territory comprising a 5 county of this state as such county existed on the first 6 day of January, one thousand nine hundred ninety, 7 notwithstanding any boundary changes thereof made 8 subsequent thereto; $\mathbf{2}$

(2) "Block", "block group", "census tract" and 9 "voting district" mean those geographic areas as 10 defined by the bureau of the census of the United 11 12 States department of commerce for the taking of the 13 one thousand nine hundred ninety census of popula-14 tion and described on census maps prepared by the 15 bureau of the census. Such maps are, at the time of this enactment, maintained by the bureau of the 16 17 census and filed in the office of legislative services;

(3) "Magisterial district" means the territory comprising a magisterial district of this state as reported to
and used by the bureau of the census of the United
States department of commerce for the taking of the
one thousand nine hundred ninety census of population and described on census maps prepared by the
bureau of the census;

(4) "Incumbent senator" means a senator elected at
the general election held in the year one thousand
nine hundred ninety or at any general election thereafter, with an unexpired term of at least two years in
duration.

30 (c) The Legislature recognizes that in dividing the state into senatorial districts, the Legislature is bound 31 32not only by the United States constitution but also by the West Virginia constitution; that in any instance 33 34 where the West Virginia constitution conflicts with the United States constitution, the United States constitu-35 36 tion must govern and control, as recognized in section 37 one, article one of the West Virginia constitution; that 38 the United States constitution, as interpreted by the 39 United States supreme court and other federal courts, 40 requires state legislatures to be apportioned so as to achieve equality of population as near as is practicable, 41 population disparities being permissible where justi-42 fied by rational state policies; and that the West 43 44 Virginia constitution requires two senators to be 45 elected from each senatorial district for terms of four years each, one such senator being elected every two 46 47 years, with one half of the senators being elected 48 biennially, and requires senatorial districts to be 49 compact, formed of contiguous territory and bounded

50 by county lines. The Legislature finds and declares 51 that it is not possible to divide the state into senatorial 52 districts so as to achieve equality of population as near 53 as is practicable as required by the United States supreme court and other federal courts and at the 54 55 same time adhere to all of these provisions of the West Virginia constitution; but that, in an effort to adhere 56 as closely as possible to all of these provisions of the 57 58 West Virginia constitution, the Legislature, in dividing the state into senatorial districts, as described and 59 constituted in subsection (d) hereof, has: 60

61 (1) Adhered to the equality of population concept, 62 while at the same time recognizing that from the 63 formation of this state in the year one thousand eight 64 hundred sixty-three, each constitution of West Vir-65 ginia and the statutes enacted by the Legislature have 66 recognized political subdivision lines and many func-67 tions, policies and programs of government have been 68 implemented along political subdivision lines;

(2) Made the senatorial districts as compact as
possible, consistent with the equality of population
concept;

(3) Formed the senatorial districts of "contiguous
territory" as that term has been construed and applied
by the West Virginia supreme court of appeals;

75 (4) Deviated from the long-established state policy, 76 recognized in (1) above, by crossing county lines only when necessary to ensure that all senatorial districts 77 were formed of contiguous territory or when adher-78 ence to county lines produced unacceptable population 79 inequalities and only to the extent necessary in order 80 81 to maintain contiguity of territory and to achieve acceptable equality of population; and 82

(5) Also taken into account in crossing county lines,
to the extent feasible, the community of interests of
the people involved.

86 (d) The Senate shall be composed of thirty-four
87 senators, one senator to be elected at the general
88 election to be held in the year one thousand nine

89 hundred ninety-two, and biennially thereafter for a
90 four-year term from each of the senatorial districts
91 hereinafter in this subsection described and consti92 tuted as follows:

392 (17) The county of Kanawha shall constitute the393 seventeenth senatorial district.

394 (e) The West Virginia constitution further provides, in section four, article VI thereof, that where a 395 senatorial district is composed of more than one 396 county, both senators for such district shall not be 397 398 chosen from the same county, a residency dispersal 399 provision which is clear with respect to senatorial districts which follow county lines, as required by such 400 401 constitution, but which is not clear in application with respect to senatorial districts which cross county lines. 402However, in an effort to adhere as closely as possible 403 to the West Virginia constitution in this regard, the 404 405 following additional provisions, in furtherance of the rationale of such residency dispersal provision and to 406 407 give meaning and effect thereto, are hereby 408 established:

409 (1) With respect to a senatorial district which is 410 composed of one or more whole counties and one or 411 more parts of another county or counties, no more 412 than one senator shall be chosen from the same 413 county or part of a county to represent such senatorial 414 district;

415 (2) With respect to a senatorial district which does 416 not contain any whole county but only parts of two or 417 more counties, no more than one senator shall be 418 chosen from the same part to represent such senato-419 rial district; and


420 (3) With respect to superimposed senatorial districts421 which contain only one whole county, all senators422 shall be chosen from such county to represent such423 senatorial districts.

424 (f) Candidates for the Senate shall be nominated as 425provided in section four, article five, chapter three of 426 this code, except that such candidates shall be nomi-427nated in accordance with the residency dispersal 428 provisions specified in section four, article VI of the 429West Virginia constitution and the additional residency 430dispersal provisions specified in subsection (e) hereof. 431 Candidates for the Senate shall also be elected in 432accordance with the residency dispersal provisions specified in said section four, article VI of the West 433° 434Virginia constitution and the additional residency 435dispersal provisions specified in subsection (e) hereof. 436 In furtherance of the foregoing provisions of this 437subsection (f), no person may file a certificate of 438 candidacy for election from a senatorial district 439described and constituted in subsection (d) hereof if he 440 or she resides in the same county and the same such senatorial district wherein also resides an incumbent 441 442senator, whether the senatorial district wherein such 443 incumbent senator resides was described and consti-444 tuted by chapter ninety-nine, acts of the Legislature, 445 one thousand nine hundred eighty-two, or was des-446 cribed and constituted in subsection (d) hereof. Any 447 vacancy in a nomination shall be filled, any appoint-448 ment to fill a vacancy in the Senate shall be made, and 449any candidates in an election to fill a vacancy in the 450Senate shall be chosen, so as to be consistent with the 451 residency dispersal provisions specified in section four, 452 article VI of the West Virginia constitution and the 453additional residency dispersal provisions specified in 454 subsection (e) hereof.

(g) Regardless of the changes in senatorial district
boundaries made by the provisions of subsection (d)
hereof, all senators elected at the general election held

in the year one thousand nine hundred eighty-eight 458 459 and at the general election held in the year one thousand nine hundred ninety shall continue to hold 460 their seats as members of the Senate for the term, and 461 as representatives of the senatorial district, for which 462 each thereof, respectively, was elected. Any appoint-463 ment made or election held to fill a vacancy in the 464 Senate shall be for the remainder of the term, and as 465 a representative of the senatorial district, for which 466 467 the vacating senator was elected or appointed, and any such election shall be held in the district as the same 468 469 was described and constituted at the time the vacating 470 senator was elected or appointed.

471 (h) The secretary of state may promulgate rules and
472 regulations to implement the provisions of this section,
473 including emergency rules and regulations promul474 gated pursuant to the provisions of section five, article
