AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation of federal funds out of the treasury from the balance of all federal funds remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-two, to the department of commerce, labor and environmental resources, division of forestry, account no. 4650, supplementing chapter thirteen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-one, known as the budget bill.

WHEREAS, The governor has established the receipt and availability of federal funds for the extension of continuing programs, now available for expenditure in the current fiscal year of 1991-1992, a part of which balance is hereby appropriated by the terms of this supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That account no. 4650, chapter thirteen, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred

ninety-one, known as the budget bill, be supplemented by adding the following sum to the designated line item:

9 The purpose of this supplementary appropriation bill
10 is to supplement this account in the budget bill for
11 fiscal year 1991-1992 by adding to this existing line item
12 an amount to be used for the southern West Virginia
13 forest fire suppression and mobilization pilot project,
14 for basic background studies under the economic
15 stability through forestry program and for the Amer-
16 ica the beautiful tree-planting program. Such
17 increased amount shall be available for such use and
18 expenditure upon passage of the bill.
