### Senate Bill No. 63

(BY SENATORS SPEARS, BRACKENRICH AND BOLEY)

[Passed March 3, 1992; to take effect July 1, 1992.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the state building commission.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section one, article six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### **ARTICLE 6. STATE BUILDING COMMISSION.**

**§5-6-1. Name of state office building commission changed; composition; appointment, terms and qualifications of members; chairman and secretary; compensation and expenses; powers and duties generally; frequency of meetings; continuation.**

1 "The State Office Building Commission of West  
2 Virginia", heretofore created, shall continue in exis-  
3 tence but on and after the ninth day of February, one  
4 thousand nine hundred sixty-six, shall be known and  
5 designated as "The State Building Commission of West  
6 Virginia" and shall continue as a body corporate and  
7 as an agency of the state of West Virginia. On and

8 after the date aforesaid, the commission shall consist  
9 of the governor, attorney general, state treasurer and  
10 four additional members to be appointed by the  
11 governor by and with the advice and consent of the  
12 Senate. The terms of office for said members to be  
13 appointed by the governor shall be four years, except  
14 that the terms of office of the first four members so  
15 appointed by the governor shall be for one, two, three  
16 and four years respectively. No more than three of  
17 such members so appointed by the governor shall be  
18 members of the same political party, nor shall any of  
19 said members be members or employees of the execu-  
20 tive, legislative or judicial branches of government of  
21 West Virginia or any political subdivision thereof. The  
22 governor shall be chairman of the commission. The  
23 secretary of state shall be a member of the commission  
24 and serve as its secretary, but shall not have the right  
25 to vote upon matters before the commission. All  
26 members of the commission shall be citizens and  
27 residents of this state. The members of the commission  
28 shall be paid or reimbursed for their necessary  
29 expenses incurred under this article, but shall receive  
30 no compensation for their services as members or  
31 officers of the commission: *Provided*, That each  
32 member of the commission appointed by the governor  
33 shall, in addition to such reimbursement for necessary  
34 expenses receive a per diem of thirty-five dollars for  
35 each day or substantial portion thereof that he is  
36 engaged in the work of the commission. Such expenses  
37 and per diem shall be paid solely from funds provided  
38 under the authority of this article, and the commission  
39 shall not proceed to exercise or carry out any author-  
40 ity or power herein given it to bind said commission  
41 beyond the extent to which money has been provided  
42 under the authority of this article. On or before the  
43 fifteenth day of each month, the commission shall  
44 prepare and transmit to the president and minority  
45 leader of the Senate and the speaker and the minority  
46 leader of the House of Delegates a report covering the  
47 activities of the said commission for the preceding  
48 calendar month.

49 Pursuant to the provisions of section four, article

50 ten, chapter four of this code, the state building  
51 commission shall continue to exist until the first day  
52 of July, one thousand nine hundred ninety-three, to  
53 allow for the completion of an audit by the joint  
54 committee on government operations.
