#### Senate Bill No. 23

(Senators Brackenrich and Wiedebusch)

[Passed April 7, 1993; to take effect July 1, 1993.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, article three-a, chapter twenty-nine-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuation of the legislative oversight commission on education accountability.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eleven, article three-a, chapter twenty-ninea of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 3A. HIGHER EDUCATION RULE MAKING.

## §29A-3A-11. Creation of a legislative oversight commission on education accountability; continuation.

- 1 (a) There is hereby created a joint commission of the
- 2 Legislature known as the legislative oversight commis-
- 3 sion on education accountability to review all legisla 4 tive rules of the board and such other rules as the
- 5 commission deems appropriate. The commission shall
- 6 be composed of six members of the Senate appointed
- 7 by the president of the Senate and six members of the

8 House of Delegates appointed by the speaker of the 9 House of Delegates. No more than five of the six 10 members appointed by the president of the Senate and 11 the speaker of the House of Delegates, respectively, 12 may be members of the same political party. In 13 addition, the president of the Senate and the speaker 14 of the House of Delegates shall be ex officio nonvoting 15 members of the commission and shall designate the 16 cochairmen. At least one of the Senate members and 17 one of the House members shall be members of the 18 committee on education of the Senate and House, 19 respectively, and at least one of the Senate members 20 and at least one of the House members shall be a 21 member of the committee on finance of the Senate and House, respectively. The members shall serve 23 until their successors shall have been appointed as 24 heretofore provided. Members of the commission shall receive such compensation and expenses as provided 26 in article two-a, chapter four of this code. Such 27 expenses and all other expenses including those 28 incurred in the employment of legal, technical, inves-29 tigative, clerical, stenographic, advisory and other 30 personnel shall be paid from an appropriation to be 31 made expressly for the legislative oversight commis-32 sion on education accountability, but if no such 33 appropriation be made, such expenses shall be paid 34 from the appropriation under "Account No. 103 for 35 Joint Expenses", but no expense of any kind whatever 36 payable under said account no. 103 for joint expenses 37 shall be incurred unless first approved by the joint 38 committee on government and finance. The commis-39 sion shall meet at any time both during sessions of the Legislature and in the interim.

- 41 (b) The commission may adopt such rules of proce-42 dure as it considers necessary for the submission, 43 presentation and consideration of rules.
- 44 (c) After having conducted a performance audit 45 through its joint committee on government operations, 46 pursuant to section nine, article ten, chapter four of 47 this code, the Legislature hereby finds and declares 48 that the legislative oversight commission on education

49 accountability should be continued and reestablished.
50 Accordingly, notwithstanding the provisions of section
51 four of said article, the legislative oversight commis52 sion on education accountability shall continue to exist
53 until the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred
54 ninety-eight. If such commission is terminated pursu55 ant to this subsection, any report required to be
56 submitted to it shall instead be submitted to the joint
57 committee on education of the Legislature.
