[Passed March 17, 1994; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation of public moneys out of the treasury to the department of health and human resources, division of health—hospital services revenue account (special fund) (capital improvement, renovation and operations), “former” account no. 8500, “WVFIMS” account no. fund 5156, fiscal year 1994, organization 0506, from the balance of moneys remaining unappropriated in the designated account for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-four, supplementing and amending chapter one, acts of the Legislature, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-three, known as the budget bill.

WHEREAS, It appears that there now remains unappropriated a balance in “former” account no. 8500, “WVFIMS” account no. fund 5156, fiscal year 1994, organization 0506, available for further appropriation during the fiscal year 1993-1994, a portion of which is hereby appropriated by the terms of this supplementary appropriation bill; therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the total appropriation to “former” account no. 8500, “WVFIMS” account no. fund 5156, fiscal year 1994, organization 0506, chapter one, acts of the Legislature, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-three, known as the budget bill, be supplemented and amended thereafter to read as follows:

7 The purpose of this supplementary appropriation bill
8 is to supplement and amend this account in the budget
9 act for the fiscal year 1993-1994 from the unappropri-
10 ated balance by adding six million, eight hundred
11 thousand dollars to the institutional facilities operations
12 line item, by adding ninety-five million, nine hundred
13 eighty thousand dollars to the medical services trust
14 fund—transfer line item, and by creating a new item of
15 appropriation to facilitate payment of the broad based
16 provider tax, for a total increase in authorized spending
17 authority of one hundred seven million, four hundred
18 nineteen thousand, five hundred ninety-three dollars to
19 be available for expenditure upon passage of this bill.

20 From the above increase to the appropriation for

21 Institutional Facilities Operations, not less than two
22 million, four hundred thirty thousand, six hundred
23 eighty dollars shall be expended for the purpose of
24 repairs and alterations and three hundred thousand
25 dollars shall be transferred to the City of Weston to
26 upgrade the sewage system to accommodate the new
27 Weston State Hospital.
