

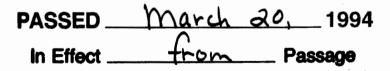

# Senate Bill No. 1009

(By Senators Burdette, Mr. President, and Boley, By Request of the Executive.)

[Passed March 20, 1994; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT making appropriations of public money out of the treasury in accordance with section fifty-one, article six of the constitution.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

TITLE I—GENERAL PROVISIONS.

1 Section 1. General policy.—The purpose of this bill is

2 to appropriate money necessary for the economical and

- 3 efficient discharge of the duties and responsibilities of4 the state and its agencies during the fiscal year one
- 5 thousand nine hundred ninety-five.
- 6 Sec. 2. Definitions.—For the purpose of this bill:

7 "Governor" shall mean the governor of the state of8 West Virginia.

9 "Code" shall mean the code of West Virginia, one 10 thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended.

"Spending unit" shall mean the department, division,office, board, commission, agency or institution to whichan appropriation is made.

The "fiscal year one thousand nine hundred ninetyfive" shall mean the period from July first, one thousand
nine hundred ninety-four, through June thirtieth, one
thousand nine hundred ninety-five.

"General revenue fund" shall mean the general
operating fund of the state and includes all moneys
received or collected by the state except as provided in
section two, article two, chapter twelve of the code or as
otherwise provided.

"Special revenue funds" shall mean specific revenue
sources which by legislative enactments are not required
to be accounted for as general revenue, including federal
funds.

27"From collections" shall mean that part of the total appropriation which must be collected by the spending 28 unit to be available for expenditure. If the authorized 29amount of collections is not collected, the total appropri-30 31ation for the spending unit shall be reduced automatically by the amount of the deficiency in the collections. 3233 If the amount collected exceeds the amount designated 34 "from collections," the excess shall be set aside in a special surplus fund and may be expended for the 35 purpose of the spending unit as provided by article two, 36 chapter five-a of the code. 37

38 Sec. 3. Classification of appropriations.—An appropri 39 ation for:

"Personal services" shall mean salaries, wages and
other compensation paid to full-time, part-time and
temporary employees of the spending unit but shall not
include fees or contractual payments paid to consultants
or to independent contractors engaged by the spending

45 unit.

46 Unless otherwise specified, appropriations for 47 "personal services" shall include salaries of heads of 48 spending units.

"Annual increment" shall mean funds appropriated for
"eligible employees" and shall be disbursed only in
accordance with article five, chapter five of the code.

52 Funds appropriated for "annual increment" shall be 53 transferred to "personal services" or other designated 54 items only as required.

55 "Employee benefits" shall mean social security matching, workers' compensation, unemployment 56 57 compensation, pension and retirement contributions. 58 public employees insurance matching, personnel fees or 59 any other benefit normally paid by the employer as a 60 direct cost of employment. Should the appropriation be 61insufficient to cover such costs, the remainder of such cost shall be transferred by each spending unit from its 6263 "personal services" line item or its "unclassified" line 64 item to its "employee benefits" line item. If there is no appropriation for "employee benefits," such costs shall 65be transferred by each spending unit from its "personal 66 67 services" line item or its "unclassified" line item. Each 68 spending unit is hereby authorized and required to make 69 such payments in accordance with the provisions of 70article two, chapter five-a of the code.

Each spending unit shall be responsible for all
contributions, payments or other costs related to
coverage and claims of its employees for unemployment
compensation. Such expenditures shall be considered an
employee benefit.

"Current expenses" shall mean operating costs other
than personal services and shall not include equipment,
repairs and alterations, buildings or lands.

79 Each spending unit shall be responsible for and 80 charged monthly for all postage meter service and shall reimburse the appropriate revolving fund monthly for all
such amounts. Such expenditures shall be considered a
current expense.

"Equipment" shall mean equipment items which have
an appreciable and calculable period of usefulness in
excess of one year.

87 "Repairs and alterations" shall mean routine 88 maintenance and repairs to structures and minor 89 improvements to property which do not increase the 90 capital assets.

"Buildings" shall include new construction and major
alteration of existing structures and the improvement of
lands and shall include shelter, support, storage,
protection or the improvement of a natural condition.

"Lands" shall mean the purchase of real property orinterest in real property.

97 "Capital outlay" shall mean and include buildings,
98 lands or buildings and lands, with such category or item
99 of appropriation to remain in effect as provided by
100 section twelve, article three, chapter twelve of the code.

101 From appropriations made to the spending units of 102 state government, upon approval of the governor there 103 may be transferred to a special account an amount 104 sufficient to match federal funds under any federal act.

105 Appropriations classified in any of the above categories shall be expended only for the purposes as defined 106 above and only for the spending units herein designated: 107 Provided, That the secretary of each department shall 108 have the authority to transfer within the department 109 110 those funds appropriated to the various agencies of the 111 department: *Provided*, *however*, That no more than five percent of the funds appropriated to any one agency or 112113 board may be transferred to other agencies or boards within the department: Provided further, That the 114 secretary of each department and the director, commis-115116sioner, executive secretary, superintendent, chairman or

117 any other agency head not governed by a departmental 118 secretary as established by chapter five-f of the code 119 shall have the authority to transfer funds appropriated 120 to "personal services" and "employee benefits" to other 121 lines within the same account and no funds from other 122 lines shall be transferred to the "personal services" line: 123 And provided further, That if the Legislature by 124 subsequent enactment consolidates agencies, boards or 125functions, the secretary may transfer the funds formerly 126appropriated to such agency, board or function in order to implement such consolidation. No funds may be 127128 transferred from a special revenue account, dedicated 129 account, capital expenditure account or any other 130account or fund specifically exempted by the Legislature from transfer, except that the use of the appropriations 131 132 from the state road fund transferred to the office of the 133secretary of the department of transportation is not a use other than the purpose for which such funds were 134135 dedicated and is permitted.

Appropriations otherwise classified shall be expended
only where the distribution of expenditures for different
purposes cannot well be determined in advance or it is
necessary or desirable to permit the spending unit the
freedom to spend an appropriation for more than one of
the above classifications.

142 Sec. 4. Method of expenditure.—Money appropriated 143 by this bill, unless otherwise specifically directed, shall 144 be appropriated and expended according to the 145 provisions of article three, chapter twelve of the code or 146 according to any law detailing a procedure specifically 147 limiting that article.

Funds of the state of West Virginia not heretofore classified as to purpose and existing within the funds of the treasury shall be determined by the governor and transferred to a special account for the purpose of expenditure as part of the general fund of the state.

153 Sec. 5. Maximum expenditures.—No authority or 154 requirement of law shall be interpreted as requiring or

permitting an expenditure in excess of the appropria-tions set out in this bill.

The appropriations for the senate for the fiscal year
1993-94 are to remain in full force and effect and are
hereby reappropriated to June 30, 1995. Any balances so
reappropriated may be transferred and credited to the
1994-95 accounts.

Upon the written request of the clerk of the senate, the
auditor shall transfer amounts between items of the total
appropriation in order to protect or increase the
efficiency of the service.

The clerk of the senate, with the approval of the president, is authorized to draw his or her requisitions upon the auditor, payable out of the Current Expenses and Contingent Fund of the senate, for any bills for supplies and services that may have been incurred by the senate and not included in the appropriation bill, for supplies and services incurred in preparation for the opening, the conduct of the business and after adjournment of any regular or extraordinary session, and for the necessary operation of the senate offices, the requisitions for which are to be accompanied by bills to be filed with the auditor.

34 The clerk of the senate, with the written approval of the president, or the president of the senate shall have 35 36 authority to employ such staff personnel during any 37session of the Legislature as shall be needed in addition 38 to staff personnel authorized by the senate resolution 39 adopted during any such session. The clerk of the senate, with the written approval of the president, or the 40 president of the senate shall have authority to employ 41 42 such staff personnel between sessions of the Legislature as shall be needed, the compensation of all staff 43personnel during and between sessions of the Legisla-44 45 ture, notwithstanding any such senate resolution, to be fixed by the president of the senate. The clerk is hereby 46 47authorized to draw his or her requisitions upon the auditor for the payment of all such staff personnel for 48 such services, payable out of the appropriation for 4950 Compensation and Per Diem of Officers and Employees or Current Expenses and Contingent Fund of the senate. 51

52 For duties imposed by law and by the senate, the clerk 53 of the senate shall be paid a monthly salary as provided 54 by the senate resolution, unless increased between 55 sessions under the authority of the president, payable 56 out of the appropriation for Compensation and Per Diem 57 of Officers and Employees or Current Expenses and 58 Contingent Fund of the senate.

The distribution of the blue book shall be by the office of the clerk of the senate and shall include seventy-five copies for each member of the Legislature and two copies for each classified and approved high school and junior high school and one copy for each elementary school within the state.

17 The clerk of the house of delegates, with the approval 18 of the speaker, is authorized to draw his or her requisi-19 tions upon the auditor, payable out of the Current 20Expenses and Contingent Fund of the house of delegates, 21for any bills for supplies and services that may have been 22incurred by the house of delegates and not included in 23the appropriation bill, for bills for services and supplies 24incurred in preparation for the opening of the session 25and after adjournment, and for the necessary operation 26of the house of delegates' offices, the requisitions for 27which are to be accompanied by bills to be filed with the auditor. 28

29 The speaker of the house of delegates, upon approval

30 of the house committee on rules, shall have authority to

31 employ such staff personnel during and between sessions

32 of the Legislature as shall be needed, in addition to 33 personnel designated in the house resolution, and the 34 compensation of all personnel shall be as fixed in such house resolution for the session, or fixed by the speaker, 35 36 with the approval of the house committee on rules, 37 during and between sessions of the Legislature, 38 notwithstanding such house resolution. The clerk of the 39 house is hereby authorized to draw requisitions upon the 40auditor for such services, payable out of the appropria-41 tion for the Compensation and Per Diem of Officers and 42 Employees or Current Expenses and Contingent Fund of the house of delegates. 43

Special revenue appropriations.—There are 2 hereby appropriated for expenditure during the fiscal 3 one thousand nine hundred ninety-five vear appropriations made by general law from special 4 5 revenue which are not paid into the state fund as general revenue under the provisions of section two, 6 article two, chapter twelve of the code: Provided, That 7 8 none of the money so appropriated by this section shall be available for expenditure except in compliance with 9 and in conformity to the provisions of articles two and 10 three, chapter twelve and article two, chapter five-a of 11 the code, with due consideration to the digest of 12 legislative intent of the budget bill prepared pursuant 1314 to article one, chapter four, unless the spending unit 15 has filed with the director of the budget, the auditor 16 and the legislative auditor prior to the beginning of each fiscal year: 17

1 Sec. 12 . State improvement fund appropria-2 tions.—Bequests or donations of nonpublic funds, 3 received by the governor on behalf of the state during 4 the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred ninety-five, 5 for the purpose of making studies and recommendations 6 relative to improvements of the administration and 7 management of spending units in the executive branch 8 of state government, shall be deposited in the state 9 treasury in a separate account therein designated state 10 improvement fund.

# TITLE III—ADMINISTRATION.

1 **Appropriations** conditional.--The Section 1. 2 expenditure of the appropriations made by this act, 3 except those appropriations made to the legislative and judicial branches of the state government, are 4 conditioned upon the compliance by the spending unit 5 with the requirements of article two, chapter five-a of 6 7 the code.

8 Where spending units or parts of spending units have 9 been absorbed by or combined with other spending 10 units, it is the intent of this act that reappropriations 11 shall be to the succeeding or later spending unit 12 created, unless otherwise indicated.

**Sec. 2**. Constitutionality.—If any part of this act is declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, its decision shall not affect any portion of this act which remains, but the remaining portion shall be in full force and effect as if the portion declared unconstitutional had never been a part of the act.

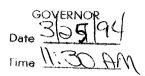
