AN ACT to amend and reenact section sixteen-b, article five, chapter forty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuation of the juvenile facilities review panel; and changing expense reimbursement of members.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section sixteen-b, article five, chapter forty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. JUVENILE PROCEEDINGS.

§49-5-16b. Juvenile facilities review panel; compensation; expenses.


- 1 The supreme court of appeals shall appoint and
- 2 maintain a five-member panel, consisting of five persons
- 3 who are willing to serve in such capacity, to visit, inspect
- 4 and interview residents of all juvenile institutions,

5 detention facilities and places in or out of the state
6 wherein West Virginia juveniles may be held involun-
7 tarily, to make public reports of such reviews:
8 *Provided*, That the panel shall not visit, inspect or
9 interview adult inmates of county jails, regional jails or
10 facilities under the direction of the commissioner of
11 corrections used for the incarceration of adult offenders
12 or detainees: *Provided, however*, That the panel shall
13 have no authority to enforce jail and prison standards for
14 county jails and regional jails as they pertain to adults
15 confined therein. In visiting and inspecting any facility
16 pursuant to the provisions of this section, the panel shall
17 have prompt and direct access to the head of the facility
18 for any purpose pertaining to the performance of
19 functions and responsibilities under this section. The
20 members so appointed shall serve without compensation
21 for their time, however, each member shall receive the
22 same expense reimbursement as is paid to members of
23 the Legislature for their interim duties as recommended
24 by the citizens legislative compensation commission and
25 authorized by law for each day or portion thereof
26 engaged in the discharge of official duties.

27 Copies of the panel's report shall be submitted
28 annually to the president of the Senate and the speaker
29 of the House of Delegates.

30 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four
31 of this code, the juvenile facilities review panel shall
32 continue to exist until the first day of July, one thousand
33 nine hundred ninety-five, to allow for the completion of
34 a performance audit by the joint committee on govern-
35 ment operations.


