AN ACT to amend and reenact sections four and five, article ten, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended; and to amend and reenact section eight-f, article twenty-one, chapter eleven of said code, all relating to continuing departments, agencies and boards; scheduling performance audits and preliminary performance reviews by the joint committee on government operations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That sections four and five, article ten, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that section eight-f, article twenty-one, chapter eleven of said code be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

CHAPTER 4. THE LEGISLATURE.

ARTICLE 10. THE WEST VIRGINIA SUNSET LAW.

§4-10-4. Termination of departments, agencies or boards following performance audits.

CHAPTER 11. TAXATION.

ARTICLE 21. PERSONAL INCOME TAX. ,

§11-21-8f. Termination of credit by law.

The tax credit allowed by this section shall be terminated on the thirty-first day of December, one

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thousand nine hundred ninety-five, unless review of the 3 4 tax credit shall be undertaken pursuant to the provi-5 sions of sections nine, ten and eleven, article ten, chapter 6 four of this code: Provided, That for those rehabilitation 7 projects for which a completed Part 2 (Description of 8 Rehabilitation) of the historic preservation certification 9 application was filed with the West Virginia division of 10 culture and history prior to that date and subsequently 11 approved in accordance with section eight-c of this 12 article, the credit shall continue to be allowed pursuant 13 to this article.

The West Virginia division of culture and history shall provide a full disclosure of applications for credit made and of credits granted pursuant to this section to the joint committee on government and finance and to the governor annually. The first report shall be presented on or before the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred ninety-five.
