[Passed February 23, 1995; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article six, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section twenty-seven, relating to the division of personnel establishing a leave donation program whereby employees may donate unused leave days to other employees in cases where a medical emergency exists; and limitation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article six, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section twenty-seven, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION.

§29-6-27. Leave donation program.

- 1 The division of personnel after consultation with other
- 2 state agencies shall establish a program under which
- 3 annual leave accrued or accumulated by an employee of

4 an agency may, if voluntarily agreed to by the employee,
5 be transferred to the annual leave account of another
6 designated employee if the other employee requires
7 additional leave because of a medical emergency. The
8 annual leave program shall be established by legislative
9 rule pursuant to the provisions of chapter twenty-nine-a
10 of this code. The division of personnel shall file such
11 legislative rule no later than the fifteenth day of July,
12 one thousand nine hundred ninety-five. The division
13 shall prepare an annual status report to be presented to
14 the joint committee on government and finance no later
15 than the fifth day of January each year. A "medical
16 emergency" means a medical condition of an employee
17 or a family member of the employee that is likely to
18 require the prolonged absence of the employee from duty
19 and which will result in a substantial loss of income to
20 the employee because of the unavailability of paid leave.
21 As used in this section, "employee" includes employees
22 in the classified and classified-exempt service and
23 employees exempt from coverage who are under this
24 article entitled to annual leave as a benefit of
25 employment: *Provided*, That none of the leave so
26 transferred may be used to qualify for or add to service
27 for any retirement system administered by the state of
28 West Virginia.




