

Senate Bill No. 194

(BY SENATORS WAGNER, BAILEY, BOWMAN, BUCKALEW, MILLER, WIEDEBUSCH AND YODER)

[Passed March 3, 1995; to take effect July 1, 1995.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article one, chapter twenty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuation of the office of water resources within the division of environmental protection.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article one, chapter twenty-two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. DIVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION.

§22-1-7. Offices within division; continuation of the water resources section.

- 1 Consistent with the provisions of this article the
- 2 director shall, at a minimum, maintain the following
- 3 offices within the division:
- 4 (1) The office of abandoned mine lands and reclama-

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5 tion, which is charged, at a minimum, with administer-

6 ing and enforcing, under the supervision of the director,

7 the provisions of article two of this chapter;

8 (2) The office of mining and reclamation, which is 9 charged, at a minimum, with administering and enforc-10 ing, under the supervision of the director the provisions 11 of articles three and four of this chapter;

(3) The office of air quality, which is charged, at a
minimum, with administering and enforcing, under the
supervision of the director, the provisions of article five
of this chapter;

(4) The office of oil and gas, which is charged, at a
minimum, with administering and enforcing, under the
supervision of the director, the provisions of articles six,
seven, eight, nine and ten of this chapter;

(5) The office of water resources, which is charged, at
a minimum, with administering and enforcing, under the
supervision of the director, the provisions of articles
eleven, twelve, thirteen and fourteen of this chapter; and

(6) The office of waste management, which is charged,
at a minimum, with administering and enforcing, under
the supervision of the director, the provisions of articles
fifteen, sixteen, seventeen, eighteen, nineteen and twenty
of this chapter.

Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of this code, the office of water resources within the division of environmental protection shall continue to exist until the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six, to allow for the completion of a preliminary performance review by the joint committee on government operations. That Joint Committee on Enrolled Bills hereby certifies that the foregoing bill is correctly enrolled.
