ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 248

(By Senators Bowman and Whitlow)

[Passed March 9, 1995; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine-a, article one, chapter fifty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to raising the cap on the number of deputy clerks from fifty-four to fifty-seven.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section nine-a, article one, chapter fifty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. COURTS AND OFFICERS.

§50-1-9a. Magistrate court deputy clerks; salary; duties.

- 1 Whenever required by workload and upon the recom-
- 2 mendation of the judge of the circuit court, or the chief
- 3 judge thereof if there is more than one judge of the
- 4 circuit court, the supreme court of appeals may by rule
- 5 provide for the appointment of magistrate court deputy

clerks, not to exceed fifty-seven in number. magistrate court deputy clerks shall be appointed by the judge of the circuit court, or the chief judge thereof if 9 there is more than one judge of the circuit court, with 10 such appointee to serve at his will and pleasure under the immediate supervision of the magistrate court clerk. 11 12 Such magistrate court deputy clerk shall have such 13 duties, clerical or otherwise, as may be assigned by the 14 magistrate court clerk and as may be prescribed by the 15 rules of the supreme court of appeals or the judge of the 16 circuit court, or the chief judge thereof if there is more 17 than one judge of the circuit court. Such magistrate 18 court deputy clerks shall also have authority to exercise 19 the power and perform the duties of the magistrate court 20 clerk as may be delegated or assigned by such magistrate 21 court clerk.

22 Such magistrate court deputy clerk shall not be a 23 member of the immediate family of any magistrate, 24 magistrate court clerk, magistrate assistant or circuit 25 court judge within the same county, shall not have been 26 convicted of a felony or any misdemeanor involving 27 moral turpitude and shall reside in the state of West Virginia. For the purpose of this section, "immediate 28 29 family" shall mean the relationships of mother, father, 30 sister, brother, child or spouse.

31 Magistrate court deputy clerks shall be paid a monthly 32 salary by the state. Such salary shall be paid on the 33 same basis and in the same applicable amounts as for 34 magistrate assistants in each county as provided in 35 section nine of this article.
