AN ACT supplementing, amending, reducing and transferring between items of the existing appropriations from state road funds to the department of transportation, division of motor vehicles, former account no. 6710, "WVFIMS" account no. fund 9007, fiscal year 1995, organization 0802, as appropriated by chapter one, acts of the Legislature, first extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-four, known as the budget bill.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That the items of the total appropriations from the state road fund to "former" account no. 6710, "WVFIMS" account no. fund 9007, fiscal year 1995, organization 0802, chapter one, acts of the Legislature, first extraordinary session, one

thousand nine hundred ninety-four, be supplemented, amended, reduced and transferred to thereafter read as follows:

26 year 1994-95.

27 The purpose of this bill is to transfer between items of  
28 existing appropriation increasing the unclassified line  
29 item and decreasing the optic scan line item and the  
30 electronic driver's license system line item for a total  
31 decrease in the appropriation of \$550,000.






