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Senate Bill No. 430

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article five-c, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to nursing, personal and residential care homes; and exempting fraternal homes from the licensing requirements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article five-c, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5C. NURSING AND PERSONAL CARE HOMES AND RESIDENTIAL BOARD AND CARE HOMES.

§16-5C-2. Definitions.

- 1 As used in this article, unless a different meaning
- 2 appears from the context:
- 3 (a) The term "director" means the secretary of the
- 4 department of health and human resources or his or her
- 5 designee;

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- (b) The term "facility" means any nursing home, personal care home or residential board and care home as defined in subdivisions (d), (e) and (f) of this section: Provided. That the care or treatment in a household, whether for compensation or not, of any person related 10 11 by blood or marriage, within the degree of consanguinity 12 of second cousin to the head of the household, or his or her spouse, may not be deemed to constitute a nursing 13 14 home, personal care home or residential board and care 15 home within the meaning of this article. contained in this article applies to hospitals, as defined 16 under section one, article five-b of this chapter; or state 17 institutions, as defined under section three, article one, 18 19 chapter twenty-five of this code or section six, article 20 one, chapter twenty-seven of this code; or nursing homes 21 operated by the federal government or the state govern-22 ment; or institutions operated for the treatment and care 23 of alcoholic patients; or offices of physicians; or hotels, 24 boarding homes or other similar places that furnish to 25 their guests only room and board; or extended care 26 facilities operated in conjunction with a hospital; or to 27 homes or asylums operated by fraternal orders pursuant 28 to article three, chapter thirty-five of this code;
 - (c) The term "limited and intermittent nursing care" means care which may only be provided when the need for such care meets these factors: (1) The resident requests to remain in the facility; (2) the resident is advised of the availability of other specialized health care facilities to treat his or her condition; and (3) the need for such care is the result of a medical pathology or a result of the normal aging process. Limited and intermittent nursing care shall only be provided by or under the direct supervision of a registered professional nurse and in accordance with rules promulgated by the board of health;
- 41 (d) The term "nursing home" means any institution, 42 residence or place, or any part or unit thereof, however 43, named, in this state which is advertised, offered, main-44 tained or operated by the ownership or management,

whether for a consideration or not, for the express or 45 implied purpose of providing accommodations and care, 47 for a period of more than twenty-four hours, for four or 48 more persons who are ill or otherwise incapacitated and in need of extensive, on-going nursing care due to 49 50 physical or mental impairment or which provides services for the rehabilitation of persons who are conva-51 52 lescing from illness or incapacitation;

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- (e) The term "personal care home" means any institution, residence or place, or any part or unit thereof, however named, in this state which is advertised, offered, maintained or operated by the ownership or management, whether for a consideration or not, for the express or implied purpose of providing accommodations and personal assistance and supervision, for a period of more than twenty-four hours, to four or more persons who are dependent upon the services of others by reason of physical or mental impairment who may require limited and intermittent nursing care, including those individuals who qualify for and are receiving services coordinated by a licensed hospice: Provided, That services utilizing equipment which requires auxiliary electrical power in the event of a power failure may not be used unless the personal care home has a backup power generator;
- (f) The term "residential board and care home" means any residence or place, or any part or unit thereof, however named, in this state which is advertised, offered, maintained or operated by the ownership or 74 management, whether for consideration or not, for the express or implied purpose of providing accommodations 75 and personal assistance and supervision, for a period of more than twenty-four hours, to four to ten persons who 78 are not related to the owner or manager by blood or marriage within the degree of consanguinity of second cousin and are dependent upon the services of others by reason of physical or mental impairment or who may require limited and intermittent nursing care but are capable of self-preservation and are not bedfast, includ-

- 85 services coordinated by a licensed hospice: Provided,
- 86 That services utilizing equipment which requires auxil-
- 87 iary electrical power in the event of a power failure may
- 88 not be used unless the residential board and care home
- 89 has a backup power generator;
- 90 (g) The term "nursing care" means those procedures
- 91 commonly employed in providing for the physical,
- 92 emotional and rehabilitational needs of the ill or other-
- 93 wise incapacitated which require technical skills and
- 94 knowledge beyond that which the untrained person
- 95 possesses, including, but not limited to, such procedures
- 96 as: Irrigations, catheterizations, special procedure
- 97 contributing to rehabilitation and administration of
- 98 medication by any method which involves a level of
- 99 complexity and skill in administration not possessed by
- 100 the untrained person;
- 101 (h) The term "personal assistance" means personal
- 102 services, including, but not limited to, the following:
- 103 Help in walking, bathing, dressing, feeding or getting in
- 104 or out of bed, or supervision required because of the age
- 105 or mental impairment of the resident;
- 106 (i) The term "patient" means an individual under care
- 107 in a nursing home;
- 108 (j) The term "resident" means an individual living in a
- 109 personal care home or a residential board and care home;
- 110 (k) The term "sponsor" means the person or agency
- 111 legally responsible for the welfare and support of a
- 112 patient or resident;
- (l) The term "person" means an individual and every
- 114 form of organization, whether incorporated or unincor-
- porated, including any partnership, corporation, trust,
- 116 association or political subdivision of the state.
- 117 The director may define in regulations any term used
- 118 herein which is not expressly defined.
