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[Passed January 26, 1996; in effect from passage.]

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AN ACT expiring funds to the unappropriated surplus balance in the state fund, general revenue, for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six, in the amount of three million five hundred thousand dollars from the West Virginia infrastructure general obligation debt service fund, fund number 3384, and four million dollars from the revenue shortfall reserve fund, account no. fund 2038, organization 0201, activity 999, and making a supplementary appropriation of public moneys out of the treasury from the unappropriated surplus balance for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six, to the governor's office—civil contingent fund, "WVFIMS" account no. fund 0105, fiscal year 1996, organization 0100.

WHEREAS, The Legislature finds that the account balance in the West Virginia infrastructure general obligation debt service fund exceeds that which is necessary for the purposes for which the account was established; and

WHEREAS, The revenue shortfall reserve fund has a sufficient balance available for appropriation in the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six; and

WHEREAS, By the provisions of this legislation there now remains an unappropriated surplus balance in the state treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six; therefore,


*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That the balance of funds available for expenditure in the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six, to the West Virginia infrastructure general obligation debt service fund, fund number 3384, be decreased by expiring the amount of three million five hundred thousand dollars to the unappropriated surplus balance of the state fund, general revenue, and that the revenue shortfall reserve fund, account no. fund 2038, organization 0201, activity 999, be decreased by expiring the amount of four million dollars to the unappropriated surplus balance of the state fund, general revenue, and that the total appropriation for fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six, to "WVFIMS" account no. fund 0105, fiscal year 1996, organization 0100, be supplemented and amended by increasing the total appropriation by seven million five hundred thousand dollars as follows:
