

## H. B. 4484

[Passed March 9, 1996; in effect ninety days from passage.]

- AN ACT to amend and reenact section five-a, article twelve, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, restricting municipal powers to limit the rights of persons with respect to firearms and ammunition; exception; and effective date.
- Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five-a, article twelve, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

- ARTICLE 12. GENERAL AND SPECIFIC POWERS, DUTIES AND ALLIED RELATIONS OF MUNICIPALITIES, GOVERNING BODIES AND MUNICIPAL OFFI-CERS AND EMPLOYEES; SUITS AGAINST MUNICIPALITIES.
- §8-12-5a. Limitations upon municipalities' power to restrict the purchase, possession, transfer, ownership, carrying, transport, sale and storage of certain weapons and ammunition.
  - 1 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of section five of

this article, no municipality, after the effective date of this
section, may enact an ordinance which is more restrictive
of a person's ability to purchase, own, possess, transfer,
transport or store a firearm or ammunition than any federal or state provision of law which restricts such ability of a
person.
(b) Nothing in this section shall limit the authority of a
municipality to enact an ordinance eventicing the authority

9 municipality to enact an ordinance exercising the authori-10 ty granted to municipalities by the provisions of subdivi-11 sion (16), section five of this article: *Provided*, That no 12 municipality shall, after the effective date of this section, 13 enact any ordinance limiting the ability of a person pos-14 sessing a state-wide license to carry a concealed weapon in 15 a manner not proscribed by federal or state law. 3 [Enr.
